LIMITED PARKING AND ENTRANCES

During this initial phase, guests will be directed to self-park in the Simba lot and enter the Downtown Disney District from the west entrance or walk from Harbor Blvd. on the east entrance



TEMPERATURE SCREENINGS PRIOR TO ENTRY

Guests with temperatures 100.4 F or above will not be allowed entry, nor will those in their party



ENHANCED CLEANING PROCEDURES

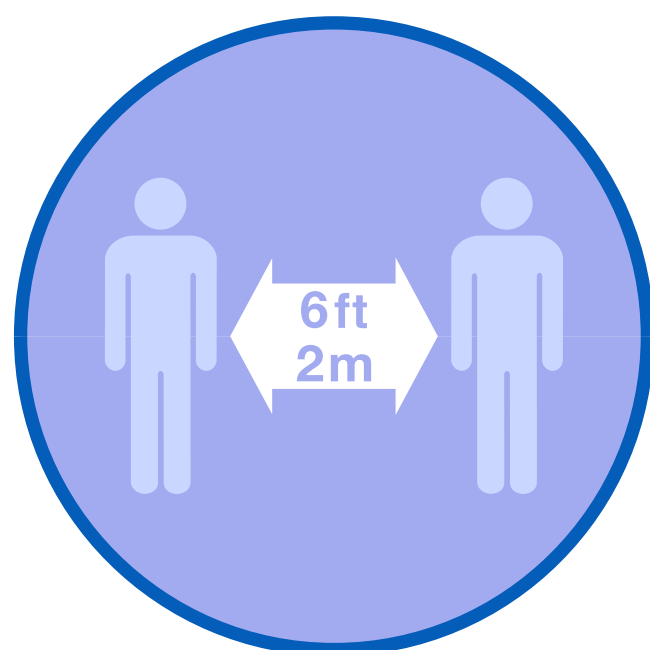
Increased focus on cleaning and sanitation, including the addition of hand sanitizer and hand-washing stations in key areas



FACE COVERINGS REQUIRED

Guests, cast members and operating participant employees will be required to wear an appropriate face covering

Guests must bring their own face coverings



PHYSICAL DISTANCING AND CAPACITY MEASURES

Ground markings and physical barriers will help promote physical distancing
